While Fred Astaire had the notoriety and acclaim as a great dancer, it was Ginger Rogers, his partner, who not only did everything that he did, but did it backwards while wearing high heels. Families who have a child with a disability remind me of Ginger Rogers. They do the multitude of tasks every other family does, plus about 10,000 extra things.

The Harris Children and Family Division helps lessen the load. Our strategy is simple. We ask what will help families most — then we work with them to do it.

Respite care is the biggest need. When we envisioned the program 10 years ago, we thought parents would use it to get a break. That may happen on occasion, but what we generally find is that parents most often use respite care to survive — to work, go to the grocery store, recuperate after surgery or attend their other child's ballet recital.

An all-inclusive fun family evening to benefit children with disabilities



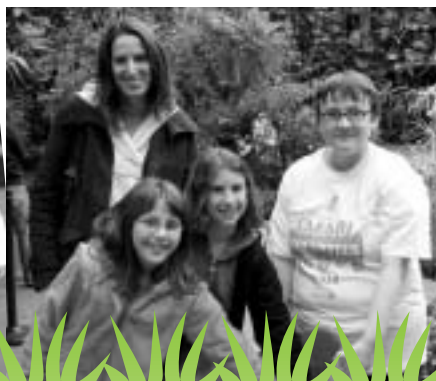

As JARC celebrates its 40th anniversary, we look back...

From the JARCives

In the mid-1960s, a group of parents met at the Detroit Jewish Community Center while their adult children with developmental disabilities gathered for a social program. Over coffee, the parents shared a number of concerns about the well-being of their children.

The conversations led to the establishment of the Parents Association for Jewish Residential Care (PAJRC). The group incorporated as a non-profit organization in 1969, and within two years, there were more than 200 members.

Eventually, PAJRC garnered the help of other community agencies and began a campaign to raise funds for a residence. After netting \$250,000, the group tried to buy a house in West Bloomfield and have it rezoned for a group home, but they were turned down by the community. In 1971, United Jewish Charities contacted PAJRC and offered to rent out a vacant converted duplex on Evergreen in Detroit that was formerly used as a temporary home for children and young adults.

Within the year, four men and three women moved into the house. It was called a Haverim home, Hebrew for friends, but it was more than a home for friends. It was a place where adults with developmental disabilities could live in dignity, and live a Jewish life. Trained staff provided 24-hour care, and residents learned household chores, how to work together and be part of a community.

Spotlight on Staff: John McCaffrey

In October 1980, JARC hired **John McCaffrey** as a direct care worker. Twenty-eight years and four positions later, John is still going strong as one of JARC's most tenured employees.

Though he had worked in management and sales prior to coming to JARC, John was very familiar with the organization's inner workings. "I have a family member who has developmental disabilities," says John, "so I was an advocate for individuals who were receiving services through JARC."

After serving as a Direct Supports Coordinator, John moved on to become an Assistant Manager of one of JARC's homes, then Manager of a home followed by becoming an Area Supervisor of all homes. For the last eight years, he has served as the Director of Community Supports for the Frankel Division, overseeing operations of JARC's residential services including licensed group homes and transition homes.

According to John, one of the reasons he loves working at JARC is the fact that all employees are extremely focused on JARC's mission. "From program staff and accounting to maintenance and support staff, everyone knows their efforts enhance the lives of those we serve," he says. "But, the most rewarding part of the job is when I see an individual that we serve take ownership in their living environment and situation. They see they are an integral part of a team that is helping them achieve their goals, make a difference and enrich their lives."

**A message from Laurel Berger
Director of the Harris Division**

I recently received a call from a mom whose son was exhibiting explosive behaviors. Because she feared for his safety, she was no longer able to take him out of the house by herself. She was exhausted, frightened and didn't know where to turn.

After meeting with the family, I matched them with Sarah, JARC respite staff person. Sarah not only gave mom and dad a break,

but she bonded with the family and demonstrated techniques that could be used to help their child. Today, the boy eagerly anticipates Sarah's visits and attends pre-school three mornings a week. He may have life-long challenges, but mom and dad no longer feel so desperate and alone.

Another program,

Club Scene, was born after many families told us of the sadness they felt over their kids with disabilities having no social life. Now, every month there are social opportunities for teens and young adults including an ethnic dining club, a theatre club and a cooking club. Friendships have formed, and two men who met at some of the activities decided that they were ready to move out on their own and wanted to be roommates. With the blessing of their families and the support of JARC staff, they are living in an apartment together.

Our School Inclusion program, which enables 16 students at six schools with disabilities to learn in the same environment as other children, is another result of parent input. The School Inclusion program provides the support to help a child succeed in private schools, from modifying the curricula to placing an aide in the classroom.

I've shared with you a bit about what the Harris Division does to help people. Your help is crucial to the continuation of these services.

Although Nancy passed away a few years ago, Joanne admits, "I look at her picture on my bulletin board and smile as I leave my house every Friday to go to the Medow Home."

In addition to her weekly visits to the Medow Home, Joanne has served on the JARC Board of Directors for nine years and also lends a hand with many fundraising projects. She chairs the *House Beautification Committee*, working in partnership with the home managers to keep the decorating and maintenance of the JARC homes to the high standards of the agency. She visits each home on a yearly basis and with input from **John McCaffrey**, the Director of Community Supports for the Frankel Division, prioritizes each homes' beautification needs.

Joining Joanne on many volunteer projects is her husband **Danny Aronovitz** and their children **Sara, Ben and Anna**. Together they have assembled and disassembled the Medow Home sukkahs, assisted at bingo games and planted flowers at numerous JARC homes. "Volunteering at JARC is very fulfilling to everyone involved," she says proudly. "I'm glad my family is involved in this venture with me and would recommend this to anyone who was looking to donate their time."

Passover Traditions Perpetuated Thanks To the David-Horodoker Fund

Passover is a special time of the year at JARC. The men and women served by JARC retell the ancient story and enjoy traditional first and second seders with the community at synagogues and temples. Much of this is made possible by the kindness and generosity of the **David-Horodoker Passover Fund**.

The David-Horodoker Passover Fund has its roots steeped in history, according to **Sue Kauffman**. Sue's cousin, **Roz Blanck** and others helped spearhead the project. "At the turn of the 20th century, the David-Horodoker's Women's Organization was started by grandmothers and mothers from the David-Horodok shtetl (village) to do charity work. In 1995, when the torch was handed down to the granddaughters of these founding women, this new generation created the David-Horodoker Passover Fund to ensure the people served by JARC would be able to participate in Passover seders.

"It was very important that this outreach seder program be continued," adds Sue. "We are attempting to follow in our families' footsteps by providing for those in the community. We welcome the participation of all those families descended from David-Horodok — men, women and children, and intend to keep the name of the David-Horodok shtetl alive as we deepen our understanding of our roots."

Interest, dividends, tributes and a portion of the fund's balance are used annually for the fund's purpose. Spendable funds are not permanent, but have a guaranteed lifespan.

Since 1971, Jenny and Laura have shared not only a close friendship, but a commitment to their community and to improving the lives of others. The roommates have been involved in many volunteer efforts, first serving as candy strippers when they were young and continuing to their current involvement in a variety of projects that benefit young and old.

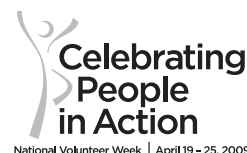
"It's so rewarding that I'm helping someone," says Laura. "I wish I could do more, but I do whatever I can."

"I'm so glad to be able to help people," adds Jenny. "The people who receive the help are so grateful, and I'm grateful to be able to help them out."

Through the years, Jenny and Laura have volunteered at the Oakland County Sheriff's Fishing Derby, where they work with children with physical and developmental disabilities; taken part in the "Fall Fix-Up" project, visiting the homes of people with disabilities or senior citizens and helping with raking, yard work and minor home repairs; assembled packages for victims of Hurricane Katrina; sewed dolls for children at Children's Hospital; packed holiday gift baskets for the needy; made Valentine's Day candy bags for orphaned children; and served dinner to the homeless.

One of the twosome's most meaningful commitments, however, is the K'ver Avot (Graves of Our Ancestors) program. The women escort seniors who have no family members to the cemetery to visit and say prayers for their departed loved ones. They help the seniors into and out of the car, hold onto them as they walk to the gravesite, help place flowers on the grave, recite prayers and embrace them when the emotions overflow.

*"Jenny and Laura donate countless hours each year to help those less fortunate than themselves," says JARC social worker **Shoshana Rubenstein**. "Their work has touched people directly through these selfless acts, enriching people's experiences and enhancing their quality of life. Most importantly, there is no end in sight for the number of volunteer projects they will continue to participate in and support and, our community is very fortunate to have their deeply heartfelt involvement."*
